- Prime Canvas's: Mini and Small canvas's to be primed (with acrylic paint) in a neutral grey colour background. And Medium and Large canvas to be primed in a Burnt Sienna (acrylic background colour)
- Bring one 'object' from home to feature in a Still Life Painting (Could be as simple as a Spoon or Ornate Bookend)
- Smart phone or iPad encouraged to bring and use for photo reference and compositional guides.
- Favourite painting you admire printed on a4 paper (for workshop activity)

Miscellaneous Items to bring:

- 2 x Large glass Jars with lids (for solvent and cleaning brushes)
- 1 x additional jar lid (for medium)
- 1 x bag of rags (to clean brushes and excess paint)
- 1 x Small bottle PVA craft glue
- 1 x Roll of Cling wrap

DAY ONE: Monday 26 June

'Colour' theme (featuring single blooms and fruit display)

- Introduction to Oil painting
- Basic oil painting materials.
- How to set up an artist's palette and an overview of the Alla Prima technique.
- discuss the layout of the week and our intentions/outcomes.
- Lots of gestural drawing exercises to warm up, which activate both left and right sides of the brain. Time limited gestural charcoal sketches of Still Life.
- Colour mixing, painting the colour wheel and establishing a full palette from Prime Colours.
- Collaborative mini paintings, which combine colour relationships, mixing and gestural techniques.
- Paired painting (described and captured) blind artist
- Canvas paper studies of single bloom/ or fruit
- Demo of worked up mini oil painting
- Finished 2 x mini canvas paintings of single bloom/ or fruit
- Display of finished works and then pack down
- How to clean your palette and brushes correctly

DAY TWO: Tuesday 27 June

'Tone and form' theme (featuring full fruit display)

- The day will begin with warm up drawing exercises with a focus on light and shadow, tone and form.
- Paper will be prepared for collage exercise.
- Collage of still life display or available reference image to be described and captured in 3 tones (using pastels).
- Light source explained and experimented in assemblage.
- Two Black and white tonal studies of display.
- Colour painted study
- Demonstration of larger colour painting
- Large painting
- Pack down

DAY THREE: Wednesday 28 June

'Composition and narrative' theme (featuring flower arrangement)

- Warm up sketching exercises.
- Multiple perspectives explained and explored (of still life and reference images provided).
- Painting image provided by participants discussed and then used as a reference image to be transcribed (focusing on composition – simplified in the alla prima technique)
- Two painted studies of still life display
- Demonstration of painting (flowers)
- Large painting
- · Pack down.

DAY FOUR: Thursday 29

'Brushwork and gestural style' objects and personal item display

- Warm up sketching exercises.
- Time limited paintings. Composing personal object in a still life scene (tone, colour, form and composition discussed)
- Demonstration on how to paint surfaces (i.e., fabric and glass)
- Tonal sketches of object composition
- Painted study of composition
- Painting of personal object on canvas.
- Pack down.

DAY FIVE: Friday 30 June

(Floral and fruit arrangement)

- Final day of workshop
- Gestural drawing exercises. Group collaborative painting agai
- Participants to choose whether they explore their own composition, or the still life on display or a reference image.
- Tonal study and painted study to be created.
- Larger painting to be the focus for the rest of the day.
- Display of outcomes/ finished work.
- Pack down.
