# BYO - The following items are not included in your registration. Please bring the following with you:

- Collection of own imagery (min 20 images) that has a personal connection to you (especially symbolic) and not larger than A4
- Magazine cutouts
- Photos
- Printed images from internet
- Own drawings
- Photocopies of your favourite artworks e.g., Birth of Venus
- Art journal (if you have one)
- Dry point etching plastic plates approx. A4 size x3
- Box of disposable gloves (approx. 100 gloves)
- Printmakers paper (white) 250gsm to 285gsm (I prefer Fabriano Rosaspina paper or Fabriano Unica paper) approx. 10 large sheets
- Clean rags/ cleaning cloths x 5
- Small watercolour palette and brush
- Dry point etching needle/scribe
- Long steel ruler approx. 45cm/60cm
- Box cutter with blade refills
- Phone book
- Paint brushes of varying sizes (cheap ones are fine) (approximately three different sizes \$20)
- PVA glue (small, approximately \$10)

#### Pencil case with:

- Pencil (HB or 2B)
- Eraser
- Coloured pencils
- Scissors
- Sharpener
- Glue stick

**PAINTS:** An array of oil paints 37ml tubes or larger (I prefer Windsor & Newton Oil paints), any preferred colours:

- Black (any)
- White (any)
- Prussian blue
- Red (any)
- Yellow (any)
- Please ensure your oils are cadmium free
