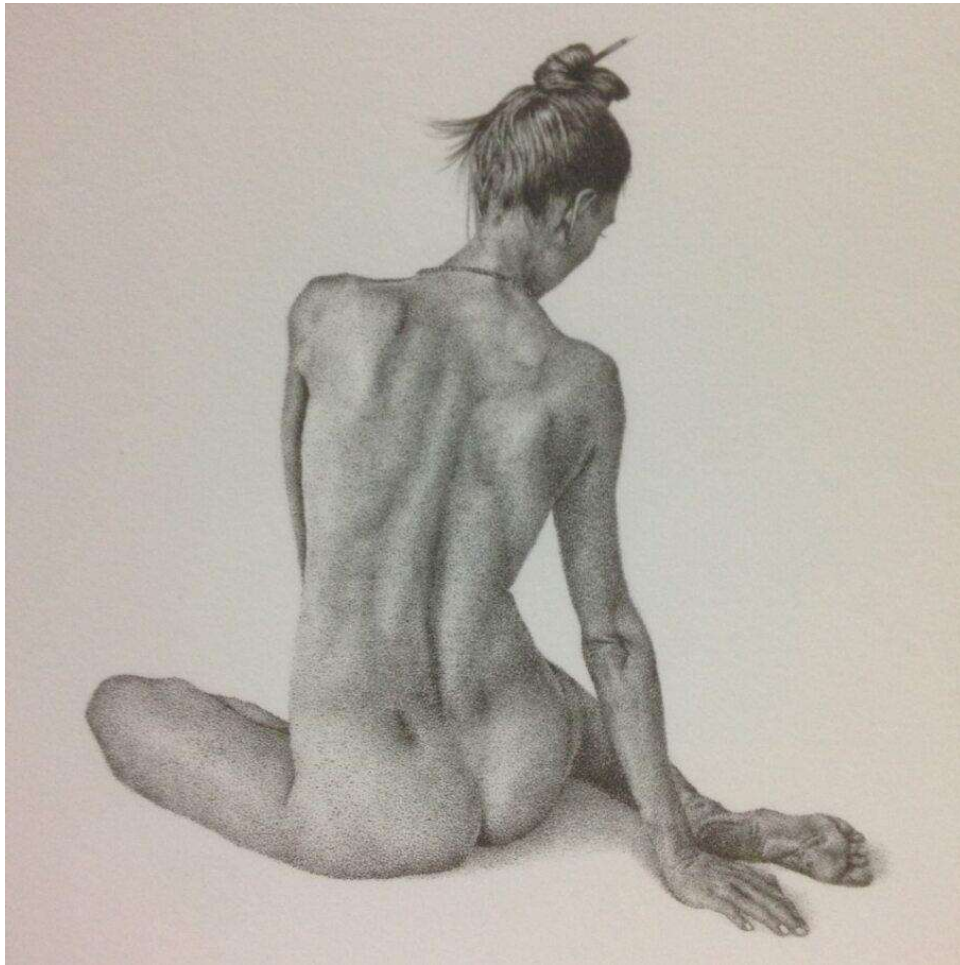

Open to students in years 11 and 12, and UniSQ Visual Arts students*

Adventure into the world of drawing with a focus on the figure. This workshop will supercharge your technical drawing skills, using graphite pencils and charcoal to accelerate your technique and anatomical understanding of the most difficult parts of figure drawing, focusing on the head, hands, and feet. Broaden your knowledge of technique with a deep dive into shading, blending, accent lines, the weight of a mark and the nature of light and tonal patterns and shapes to describe form. There is a clothed and unclothed life model present.

*Please note this includes students enrolled in the UniSQ BVSA, BCAW, and BCAR programs, or undertaking a Visual Art major in another UniSQ program.
